

The World of Living And Non-Living Things

Read the text below to explore the interesting world of living and non-living things.

Living things are organisms with life in them. They breathe, grow, and eat food. Some living things (for example, human beings and animals) can move from one place to another on their own. However, a few living organisms cannot move on their own (for example, plants). Most living organisms can also see and hear things.

Non-living things, on the other hand, are lifeless things. They can neither breathe nor grow. They are also unable to move from one place to another on their own. Some examples of non-living things include toys, utensils, perfume, clothes, chocolates, shoes, and cars.
