

# What Are Continents And Oceans

Continents are massive land areas that are separated from each other by water or other natural bodies. There are seven continents on the surface of the earth, and they cover about one-third of the world's total surface.

- Antarctica



Asia is the largest continent, and Australia is the smallest. Each continent has a wide range of different landscapes, weather, animal life, and human population.

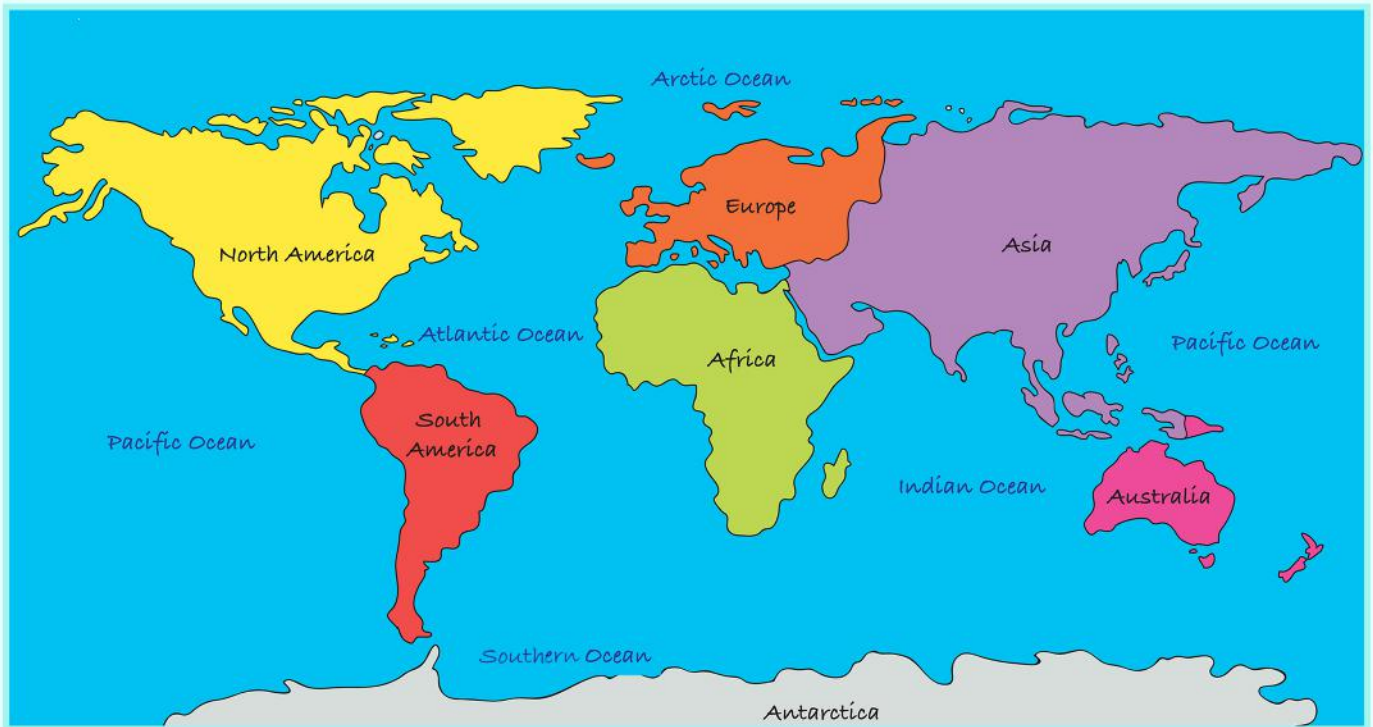
An ocean is a huge water body. All the oceans of the world cover nearly 71% of the Earth's surface. They contain about 98% of all of the Earth's

## The five oceans are:

- The Pacific Ocean
- The Arctic Ocean
- The Indian Ocean
- The Atlantic Ocean
- The Southern Ocean

Together, they can be seen as a single water body with no boundaries separating them. They are segregated according to the areas they are located in. The water in the ocean is salty.

The Pacific Ocean is the largest and the deepest, while the Arctic Ocean is the smallest of all the five oceans.
