

Identify The Traffic Signs



1. Stop Sign

The stop sign is designed to notify the drivers that they need to completely stop their vehicle. They need to make sure that the road is clear of vehicles and pedestrians before crossing the road. It is very essential to avoid accidents.



2. No U-Turn Sign

This sign prohibits drivers from taking a U-turn. You cannot make a complete turn and go in an opposite direction. It helps in the smooth flow of traffic and prevents accidents.



3. No Parking Sign

This sign indicates that vehicles are not allowed to be parked on one or both sides of the road.


It helps prevent vehicles from blocking the roads.





4. Yield Sign

The yield sign indicates that drivers must prepare themselves to stop and give way to other drivers approaching them. Following this sign helps in avoiding accidents and enables smooth traffic flow.



5. Speed Limit Sign

The speed limit sign gives the maximum permissible speed on the given road. Driving faster than that is a violation of the rule. It prevents drivers from overspeeding in crowded places.



6. No Entry Sign

This sign indicates that entry in the area where the sign is placed is prohibited. It is important to follow the rule; otherwise, one might invite police complaints.
