

Time Zones In The United States

Different time zones exist as you move from east to west or west to east on the surface of the Earth. The farther you travel, the more time zones you'll pass through. Most countries fall in the same time zone, but some large countries like the USA and Russia have different time zones within the country itself.



Each time zone in the United States is separated by an hour. So, if it is 1 o'clock in the Pacific time zone, it is 2 o'clock in the Mountain time zone, 3 o'clock in the Central time zone, and 4 o'clock in the Eastern time zone.
