

What Is The Ascending Order Of Numbers

Ascending order is a mode of arrangement where the numbers are arranged from the smallest to the largest. One easy way to remember this is, “ascending” means “going up,” so whenever you are asked to arrange in ascending order, you should start from the smallest number and go up.

In the given table, arrange the numbers in each row in ascending order, and write it in the box on the right. We have solved the first one as an example for you.
