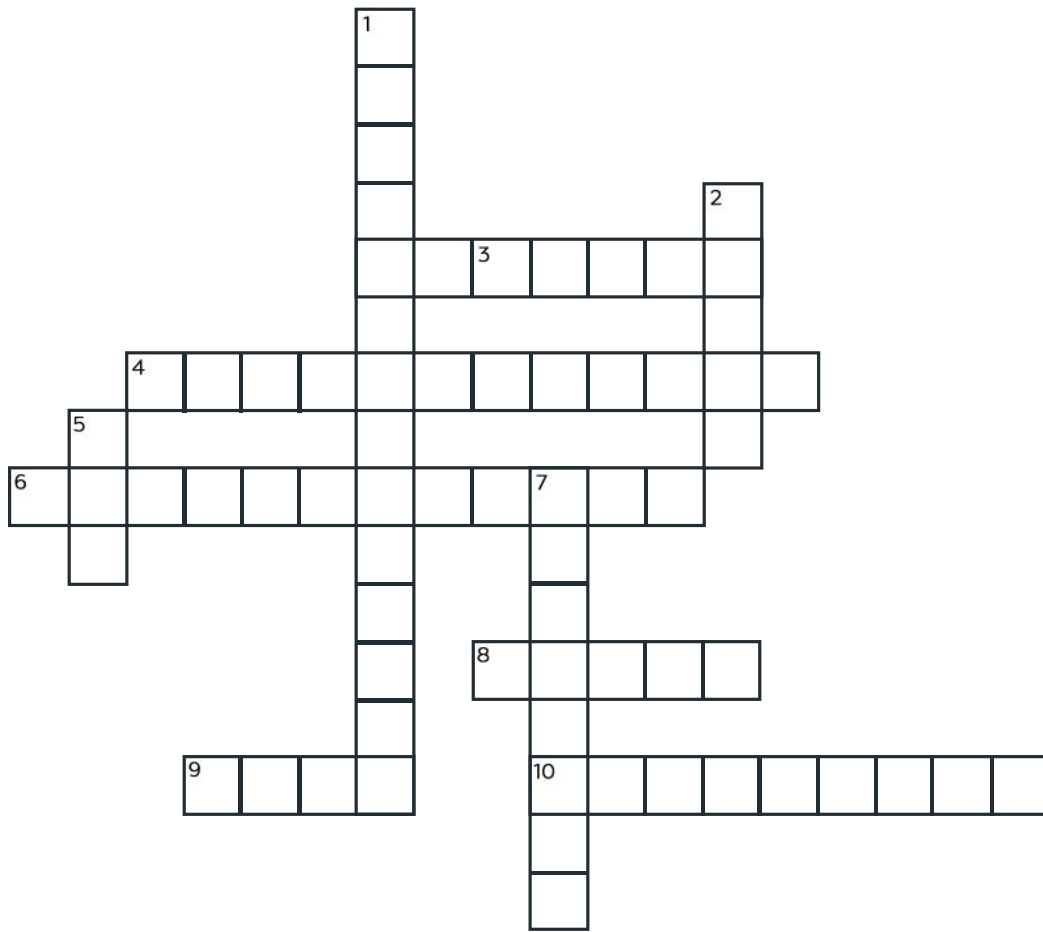


Crossword Puzzle: Lunar Eclipse
