

Solve These Two-Digit Subtraction Word Problems




Read the questions carefully and write the correct answer in the space provided. The first one is solved for your understanding.

2	My father bought 24 eggs. 10 eggs fell down and 2 were rotten. How many eggs are left?
3	Jamie had sewed 18 sweaters for the winter carnival sale. She could sell only 10 of them. How many sweaters remain with Jamie?
4	Jack, the farmer, had 56kg onions. He sold 35kg. He gave 8kg to his friend Maria. How many kilograms of onions is Jack left with?
5	Michelle had 29 sheep and 57 goats. She sold 19 sheep and 33 goats. How many sheep and goats are still with her?







6	75 students are going on a museum tour. 23 students went in the first bus, and 31 students went in the second bus. How many students went in the third bus?	
7	There are 80 horses at the stable. 23 went to the race and 15 to the veterinary doctor. How many horses are still in the stable?
