As soon as he stopped at the gas station, the man working there looked at his car in surprise. “Why do you have four penguins in your car?” he asked Austin.

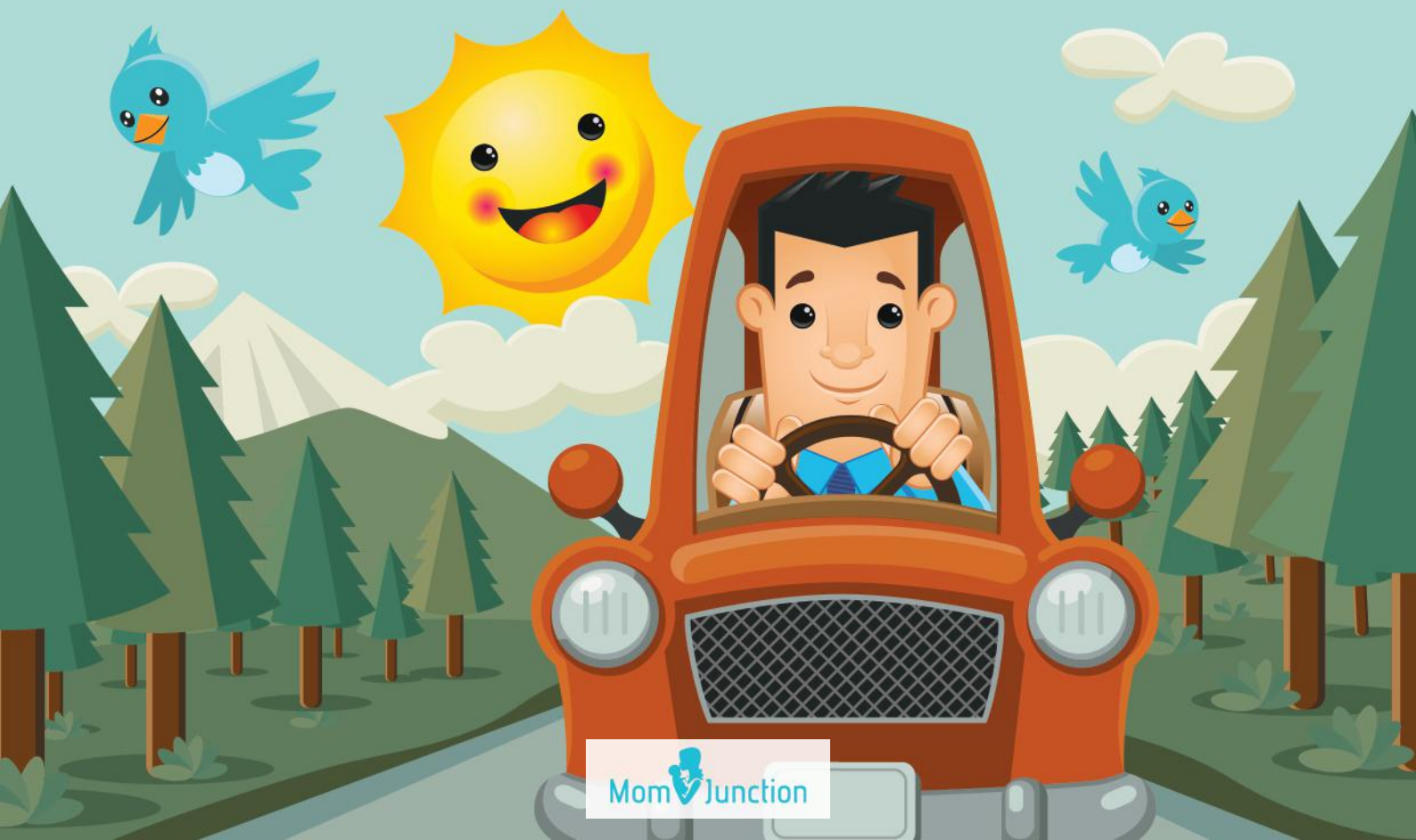

Answer the following questions based on the story.

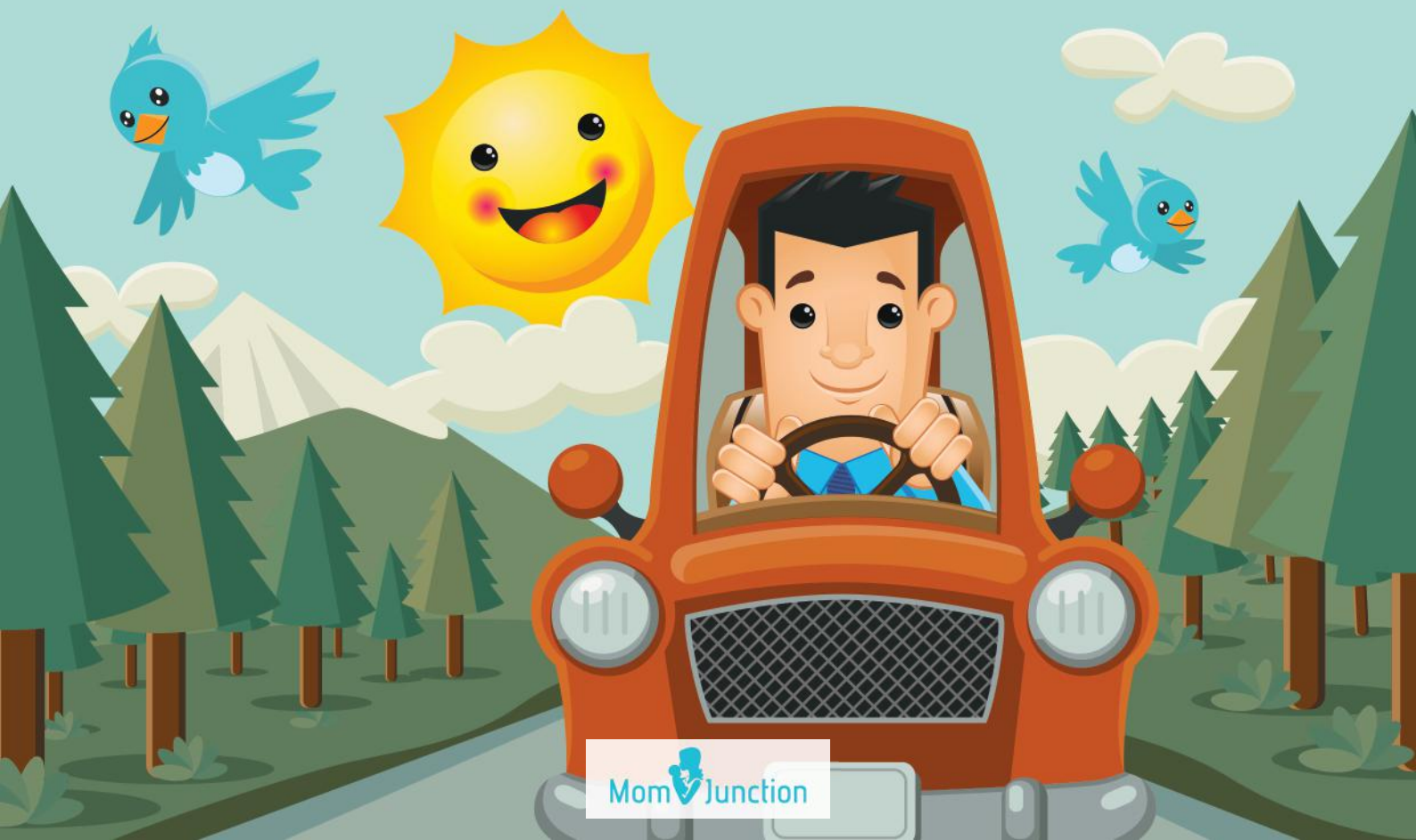
1. Where did the penguins hop into Austin's car?
