2. Museum



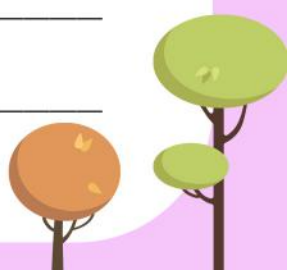
Detail 1: What is a museum → A building where objects of historical importance are stored

Detail 1: What does the word friend mean?

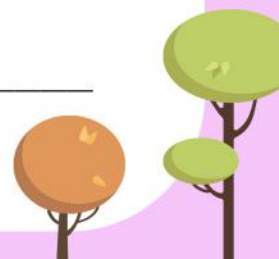
→ Someone whom you like spending time with
