

Write The Plural Forms Of Nouns

A *singular noun* represents *one* person, place, animal, thing, or idea. A *plural noun* represents *more than one* person, place, animal, thing, or idea.

To make singular nouns into plural nouns, there are two basic rules that you should follow:

1. To change regular words into plural, you just need to add “-s.”
For example: Cat—Cats; Table—Tables; House—Houses
2. For words ending in “-y” that sound like “e” or “i,” replace the last letter with “-ies.”
