



THINGS TO CHECK IN A CAR SEAT FOR CHILDREN



Opt for a car seat based on the child's age and weight.

Ensure the car seat is compatible with your vehicle.



Look for seats with easy installation, as some car seats lock with the LATCH system, while others get fixed with the car's seat belt.

Select a car seat with a five-point safety harness to keep your child secure.



Consider a car seat with side-impact protection to prevent and minimize neck and head injuries.

Ensure the car seat is made as per ASTM or CPSC standards.
