



How To Properly Wash A Sherpa Blanket?



Spot-clean the oil stains using dish liquid before machine- or hand-washing.



You may use baby powder to remove the non-oily stains from the Sherpa material.



Use gentle detergent specified for Sherpa material to clean the blanket.



Machine-wash the Sherpa blanket alone. If you are washing a couple of Sherpa blankets, note that only the same colors go together, as the dark color may bleed and dye the light-colored blanket.



Use a cold wash cycle or low-temperature settings to wash the Sherpa blanket.



Air-dry the blanket. Don't machine dry, as the polyester fabric may damage and shed.



Brush your blanket regularly to keep it soft.
