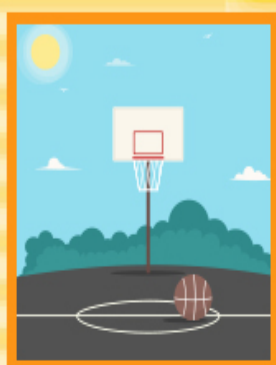


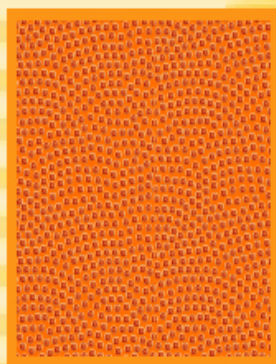
Types Of BASKETBALLS And Where To Use Them



Indoor: The most common type of basketball available in the market. They are made of leather and provide an adequate grip to hold and play. As the balls are used on polished wooden floors, they stay in condition for long.



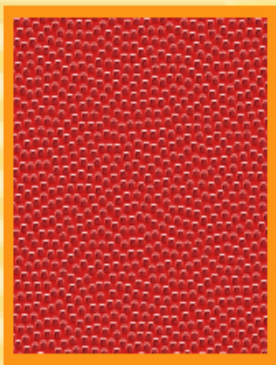
Outdoor: They are made of rubber and are often used on concrete playing surfaces. As these balls come in contact with bumps and uneven surfaces, manufacturers focus on durability rather than feel.



Hybrid: These are suitable for indoor and outdoor play as they are made of composite leather. They have an indoor basketball feel yet with outdoor ball durability.



Swimming pool: Used mainly to play in swimming pools. They are made of waterproof material and are lighter than a standard basketball. The size of the basketball may also vary.



Microfibre synthetic: Similar to hybrid balls, these balls offer more consistency than standard leather balls. They are suitable for wooden and concrete playgrounds.
