- Try a simple game of peek-a-boo.
- Children learn to realize that you hide behind the blanket.

Tactile play

- Play a game of catch or color-mixing
- It develops different sensations and stimulates motor skills and creativity.

Books

- Introduce them to books with 3D images and scenes.
- It teaches them texture and shapes while introducing the world to them.

Moving toys

- Make them play a game with a toy that moves and makes noise.
- Works on their attention, improves recognition, and exercises listening and hearing.
