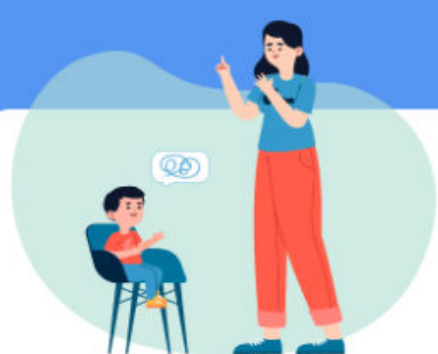




# Developmental Activities For

## *A 9-Month-Old Baby*



Imitate baby's sounds and make simple words using those sounds.



Set up toys on the ground just out of reach to encourage them to crawl, scoot, or roll to get them.



Teach simple gestures, such as waving "bye-bye" or shaking their head "no."



Provide small objects to them for picking while under supervision.



Read baby books with pictures for them.



Identify and name the objects they see and observe in their surroundings.



Place your baby near sturdy furniture to encourage them to try standing up.



Encourage them to eat their meals on their own using a spoon.
