Metals, non-metals, and metalloids are the three categories of elements in the periodic table.

The periodic table was designed in such a way as to accommodate elements that were yet to be discovered.

Except for the letter 'J,' the elemental symbols of elements in the periodic table contain all the letters of the alphabet.



Nihonium, Moscovium, Tennessine, and Oganesson are the newest elements in the periodic table, added in 2016.
