ENSURING THE ACCURACY OF A PREGNANCY TEST



Do not test too early, as it may detect a chemical pregnancy.

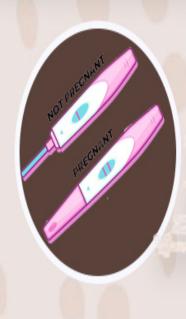




Check the expiry date of your test kit.

Read the directions carefully and follow them properly to achieve an accurate result.





If you get a positive result, wait three or four days and repeat the test. This will ensure your results are accurate.

If you still doubt your test results, talk to your doctor about a confirmatory blood test or early pregnancy ultrasound.
