

**Reason**- The baby is amazed by the visual stimulation of lights and patterns they see while rubbing the eyes.

What you can do- Try to distract them by showing a more interesting visual.

> **Reason-** The baby is sleepy. Thus rubbing helps relieve the tension and fatigue from the eyes.

What you can do- Be mindful of the signs and help them fall asleep whenever they are tired and sleepy.

**Reason-** The eyes are dry. Hence they involuntarily rub them to stimulate tears and moisten the eyes.



What you can do- You may give them a warm compress over their eyelids to prevent drying or consult their pediatrician about any required diet change or lubricants.



Reason- There is something in their eyes that is causing itchiness and irritation.

What you can do- Examine the eye and wipe away the irritant using a cold, wet cotton ball.
