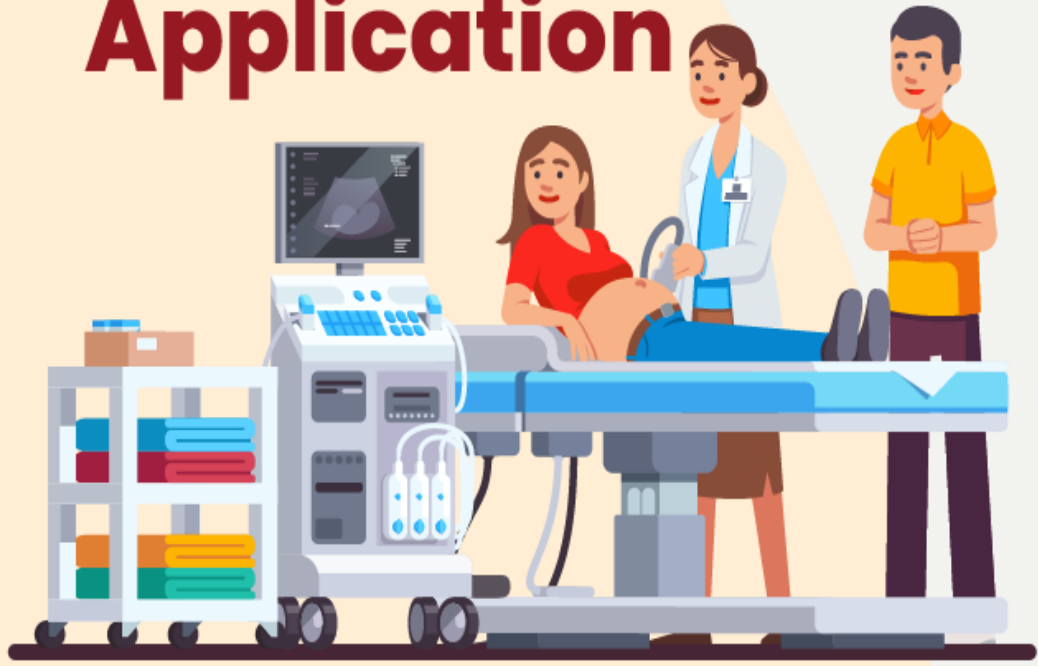


Anomaly Scan Importance And Application
