Check for the charging option - whether it charges through a power outlet, solar panels, or USB. Pick the one convenient for you.

Opt for LED lanterns as they offer high intensity, long life, and use low power.

Usually, lanterns come with a battery backup of four to eight hours. Select the lantern that offers high battery backup time.

Ensure the lantern is equipped with a standby feature. Upon power outage, the lantern should illuminate immediately.

Overcharging the lanterns may damage the battery life. Thus, pick a lantern with battery overcharging protection.

Look for lanterns with battery indicators, which alert you to charge the battery and prevent overcharging.

Ensure the lantern light is soft on your eyes and offers a gentle glow.

Select lanterns that come with a great build quality and last long.
