## Poke-A-Pumpkin



Fill some paper cups with glue tinted with red color and some with candies. Cover the cups with paper. Let children poke holes through the cups to discover their 'prize.'

## Hit The Streets

Dress up in spooky costumes, keep some props, and head out to scare people on Halloween night with your friends.



## Halloween Balloon Battle



Tie Halloween-themed balloons to the ankles of each person and make the players pop each other's balloons using their ankles.

## Pass On Scary Stories

Let everyone sit in a circle after switching off the lights. Pass on a flashlight to every member who will tell a scary story.



## Ghost Bingo



Instead of numbers, put Halloween pictures in Bingo cards. Give each player a copy and tell them to shout 'Boo' on getting a bingo.
