LAST NAMES AND THEIR MEANINGS



Anchali

The name of Cambodian origin refers to new beginnings and luck, as it means a 'greeting.'



Khemkaeng

It is a Thai-origin name that means empowering and encouraging.



Rakhang

It is a famous surname indigenous to Thailand that means 'bell' and 'chime.' Sometimes, it is referred to as a 'temple.'



Saeueng

The Chinese name "Huang" in native Thai refers to the people of higher society.



Thong di

The last name was inspired by the historic hero Phraya Pichai, who was renamed Thong di by his instructor. It means 'one with white teeth' and is of Thai origin.



Saetang

A common surname derived from the Chinese name "Tang," which means 'gift of God.'



Saeng

The native form of the Chinese name "Wu," means 'martial.' Saeng also finds its origin in Thai and means 'light.'



Phonlamai

It is a name of goodness as this surname means 'fruit' in Thai.
