

Fun Activities With NURSERY RHYMES



Read out or sing along with the child.

Encourage the child to recite the poem in different voices, such as a robot and a chipmunk.



Ask the child to gather items associated with a specific nursery rhyme from the room.

Associate a routine task with a particular rhyme and recite it with the child during that activity.



Create fill-in-the-blanks worksheets and ask the child to complete the poem.

Ask the child to jot down the sets of rhyming words from the poem.
