

Unique Naming Laws In Different Countries

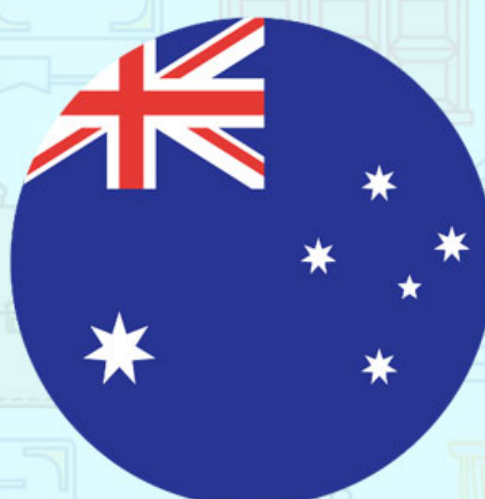


UK citizens can give a temporary name to their baby and can make changes in the future.



In many parts of the **USA**, the number of characters in the name is limited as it becomes difficult to maintain official documents for bigger names.

In **Australia**, obscene and unpleasant names, names with brackets, blank spaces, or symbols are strictly prohibited.



In **New Zealand**, any names resembling an official title or rank are not allowed.

In **Saudi Arabia**, religious and royal names and those from enemy nations are not allowed.



In **Mexico**, names derived from products, superheroes, technology, and of controversial leaders are banned.
