SCARLET FEVER

SYMPTOMS

- 1. Sore throat
- 2. Shivering
- 3. Vomiting (occasional)
- 4. Rash appears within 48 hours

POSITION OF THE RASH

- Does not appear on the face
- 2. Appears first on the neck and spreads downwards
- While fading also, it follows the same direction

CHARACTER OF THE RASH

- Fine red points
- 2. General redness and swollen skin

MEASLES

SYMPTOMS

- 1. Headache
- 2. Malaise
- 3. Mucosal inflammation on the first day
- 4. Koplik's spots occur on the second day
- 5. Rash appears on the third or fourth day

POSITION OF THE RASH

- Appears on the forehead and spreads downwards
- 2. When the rash reaches the feet,it begins to fade from the top of the body

OF THE RASH

- 1. Papular rash
- 2. A dark blotch surrounds the papule

RUBELLA

SYMPTOMS

- 1. Headache
- Mild fever
 Little or no
- malaise
 4. Mild soreness
- 5. Rash appears on the second or third day
