Baby Rubbing Ears?



Rubbing/pulling ears in babies could be normal after three months and until one year

Some babies tend to touch or **rub their ears** when bored or tired

Your baby may be rubbing/ **pulling ears as a habit** or as they discover their ears





Only ear pulling, without any other symptoms, is not always a sign of infection

Earwax buildup, which is normal and healthy in babies, could also make their ears itchy

Babies may have rubbing or itching when soap or shampoo settles in ears after bathing
