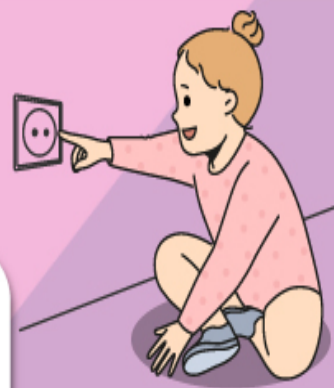


Tips To Teach Children About Electrical Safety



Ensure your children aren't climbing trees close to power lines, as the tree branches carry electricity.



It is best to keep an eye on your child when they are playing with a remote control or any other electrical device.



Avoid plugging too many electrical wires into one extension, as this could be dangerous.



Avoid leaving large appliances, such as the washing machine, on while you aren't using them. Turn them off while not in use.
