


Procedure




- Insertion of drip into the arm
- Positioning upright or on the side with assistance
- Application of cold, antiseptic solution to prepare the injection site
- Insertion of a catheter with the epidural medication into the spine
- Removal of the needle, leaving the catheter secured with a bandage

After Epidural Insertion



- May get pain relief within approximately15 minutes
- May have comfortable movement but be cautious not to dislodge the catheter
- Additional medication may be administered if needed
