Age: Check the age range mentioned on the box of the car and select the one that is appropriate for your child's age.

Speed: A relatively slower car is more suitable for a younger child, while older children and teens will enjoy playing with fast cars.



Batteries: RC cars come with replaceable and rechargeable batteries. Replacing batteries can be expensive, while rechargeable batteries need recurring charging. You can make a choice based on your preference.

Range: Look for RC cars that cover the longest distance by checking the product specifications and buyer reviews to determine the distance range.



Size: Smaller cars are suitable for indoor playing, while bigger cars are ideal for outdoors.

Toughness: The RC car should be sturdy and break-proof as it will bump into several surfaces.
