



# Fun Ways For Children To Make Friends



## You've got a friend

Play a friendship or upbeat song and let the children scatter during the song. When the music stops, they need to find a friend and hug them quickly.

## Copycat

The children should stand in a circle, and you need to tap on one of their shoulders. That child now needs to act or make a sound, and the others will repeat their actions. It will pass to whoever you tap on next.



## Show and tell

Every child has to bring one item from their home. It can be anything, such as a toy, book, cup, or blanket; they need to talk about it to others and share an interesting story about it, if any.

## The good friend lists

Take a printout of the photographs of all the children. Hand the collage to each child and ask them individually about who they consider their good friend by pointing at the photo.



## Musical chairs

Arrange chairs in a line, with each facing the opposite direction. Now the children run around the chairs to the beat of the music, and when it stops, they must find a chair to sit on. The one left behind will lose the round.
