



# ACTIVITIES TO BOOST CREATIVITY IN CHILDREN

## I KNOW A WORD GAME

Start by saying "I know a word starting with the same sound you hear at the beginning of an egg." Let children tell you the word and progress the game by asking them a word that begins with another letter.



## I NEED A SYNONYM GAME



In this vocabulary-building exercise, ask children to give you another word that means the same as a specific word.

## BRAIN SKETCHING

Make children sit in groups. Let every participant make sketches of a particular problem. They will then pass the sketch to the next person that will inspire new sketches.



## ROLL A DICE



Tell a story to the children. After that, roll a dice and ask reflective questions about the story one by one.

## MARBLING AND PRINTING

Let the child paint little cards, shells, pebbles, and similar things with different paint colors. For printing, they can dip cut portions of vegetables and press them onto the paper.



## COMIC STRIP



Start by telling a familiar story or a fairytale to the child. Let them draw pictures and create a sequence of the episode in an album or chart.
