



Check the bottle's label for the plant's Latin name, which is generally present in the authentic ones.



The pure ones often describe the part of the plant used and the extraction process on the label.



The pure ones will have a fuller and deeper aroma.



Buy the ones that are stored in dark amber bottles.



Check the price and compare it with other essential oil brands. If it's way too low, it is likely a fake one.



Squeeze a drop or two onto a piece of paper. The pure ones should evaporate quickly.
