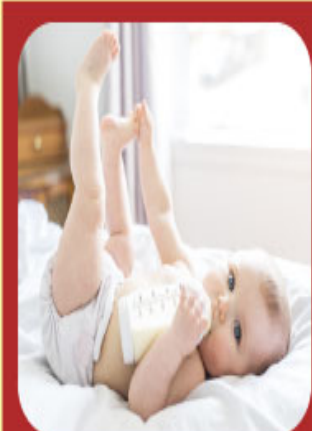




POINTS TO CONSIDER WHEN BUYING

A Bottle For Preemies



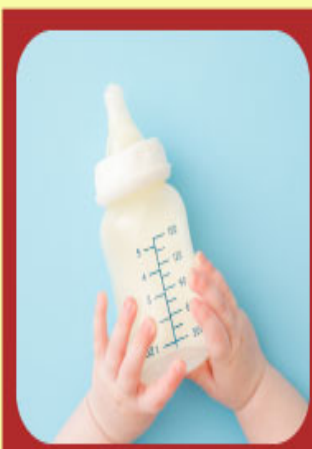
Ensure the nipple is soft and flexible to help the baby latch without difficulty.

Choose a bottle with a slow-flowing nipple to reduce the risk of choking.



Check for anti-colic valves in the nipple to reduce tummy problems.

Ensure the nipple size is appropriate for the preemie's age.



Select a bottle with measurement marks to easily keep a tab on the milk intake.

Bottles with a five-ounce capacity are sufficient for most premature babies.
