



Points To Consider When Selecting A Train Set For Toddlers



Check the age recommendation of the train set prescribed by the manufacturer.

Avoid train sets that feature small parts to eliminate the risk of choking.



Ensure plastic-based train sets are made of non-toxic, ABS-free plastic.

Make sure wooden sets are colored with child-friendly, safe dyes.



Select sets featuring a smooth and burr-free finish to prevent scratches.

Choose sets designed without sharp edges and pointed corners to prevent injuries.



Give preference to train sets that meet ASTM and CPSIA safety standards.

Opt for wooden and manual toy trains for younger toddlers.



Consider battery-powered train sets for older toddlers.

Select sets with additional accessories, such as stop signs, for an immersive experience.
