Ensure the toy is easy-to-use for the toddler.



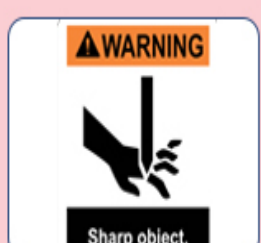
Avoid toys with small detachable units, which could pose a choking hazard.



Consider your child's interests when choosing the theme.



Ensure the toy doesn't have sharp edges or corners.



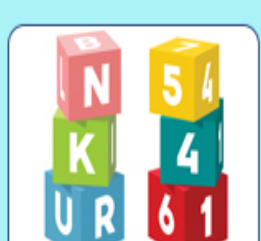
Opt for musical toys to promote creativity and sensory-based play sessions.
