

Tips For Cleaning

Bathroom Rugs



Always adhere to the cleaning instructions given on the care label.

Always
vacuum-clean the
rugs before
washing them to
remove loose dirt.





Avoid cleaning rugs with an anti-slip backing with hot water.

Avoid using bleach or vinegar to keep the anti-slip backing intact.





Add an extra rinse cycle in the washing machine to remove soap residue from the rugs.

Avoid tumble drying the rugs to protect the anti-skid backing.





Utilize a stiff-bristled brush to thoroughly scrub the rug when hand washing.

Air-dry the bathroom rug to minimize wrinkles and creases.
