



UMBILICAL MASSES

IN NEWBORN BABIES

CONDITION	CLINICAL FEATURES
Umbilical granuloma	Moist, small, red mass
Umbilical polyp	Firm, red mass
Patent urachus	Urine discharge
Umbilical hernia	Under the skin, reducible
Gastroschisis	Loop of the intestine bulge on the lateral side
Omphalocele	Sac with intestines herniate
Omphalomesenteric duct remnants	Bile or fecal discharge
