

Steps To Make Bathtubs Safe For Babies

Ensure the baby is never left alone in the bathtub to prevent them from drowning.



Always make sure the baby is sitting in the bathtub and not lying down.



Test the water's temperature before placing the baby in the bathtub.



Always hold your baby when they are in the tub to prevent them from crawling.



Check the bathtub seats regularly for any wear and tear.



Avoid bathtubs that use lead-based paint or coatings.
