TIPS TO MAKE BOOK READING Interesting For Children

Explain why you selected a book for them and what you liked about it.





Take turns to read the book aloud to each other for an immersive experience.

Keep a dictionary near the child during reading time for easy reference.





Discuss with your child about the main characters and themes of the book.

Connect the vocabulary or information in the book to real life for the child.





Ask the child what new words they learned after each reading session.

Ask the child to write a review or summary upon completing the book.





Let your child suggest an alternative ending to the story to stimulate creativity and imagination.
