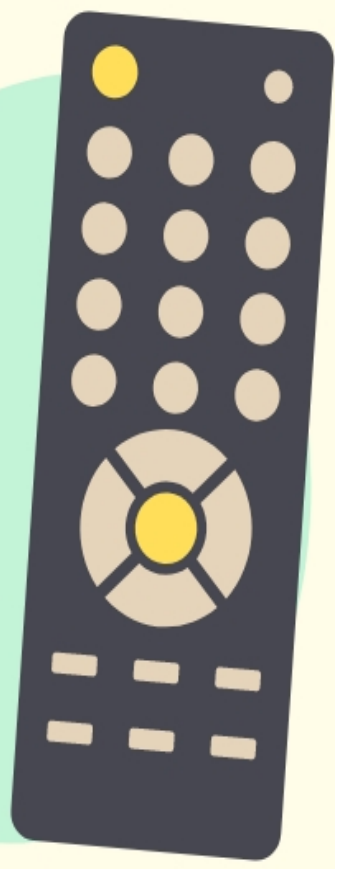


# 6 TIPS For Handling The REMOTE When Presenting



Load the remote with new batteries a day before your presentation. Ensure the batteries won't die or slow down during presentations.



Become familiar with all the buttons on the remote. Test each button on the remote and remember which buttons lead to what steps.

Practice advancing the slide without actually seeing the navigation buttons.



Hold the remote comfortably and avoid squeezing it.

Use a pointer or laser on text only when the presentation has enough text. If you are using the pointer or laser, move it slowly and steadily.



Note that modern remotes work with a wide range. So, avoid pointing the remote to your computer.
