

Preventive Measures For *Dog Bites* In Children



Avoid approaching or touching an unfamiliar pet dog or a street dog.



Quietly and confidently walk away from an aggressive dog without making eye contact.

Do not yell, run, or hit the dog.



Teach children to understand the dog's mood and behavior.

Do not bother a resting or sleeping dog.



Keep the pet dog around the family and not isolate it.

Do not always keep the dog on a leash or in a confined space.



Instruct children not to play with dogs forcefully or tease them.
