


Best Practices To Reduce The Chances Of Soap Scum Buildup



Replace your bar soap with liquid soap for a scum-free sink counter.



Utilize a soap-saver pouch if you cannot replace the bar soap.



Add Epsom salt to your bathing water to prevent scum from sticking to surfaces.



Use a squeegee to wipe dry the bathroom walls after each shower.



Follow it by using a dry sheet to spot-clean any leftover soap scum.



Use water softeners to reduce scum as well as limescale buildup.
