



Tips For Selecting Developmental Toys For A 9-Month-Old Baby

Consider toys, such as activity tables, that encourage the child to stand up.



Go for crawl-around toys that encourage the child to move and explore independently.

Pick toys that require the child to sit up and play, as they can sit for long periods.



Select toys that engage the child in picking up objects to improve their fine motor skills.

Choose musical instrument-based toys as the baby begins to bang objects at this age.



Opt for ball-based toys, as the child enjoys throwing objects at this stage.

Consider toys with recorded words and phrases as the child babbles and imitates sounds.



Go for musical toys with songs that encourage the child to sing along.
