Steps To Follow For Easy Time Recognition And Telling

Select a clock with hours, minutes, and seconds hands. Ensure the clock has pointers or numbers marked off at intervals of five from zero to 60.





Teach your child all the parts of the clock.

Start telling the time with hours. Adjust the hour hand to different numbers and minutes hand to 12 and introduce them to different hours.





Once they get the hang of hours, move to the half-hours.
Adjust the clock hands to different times with a half-hour difference.

Once they get used to the halfhour difference, you can move to the 15-minute and fiveminute difference in time.





Now, teach time past the halfhour, such as 2:45 or 7:55, where the hour hand and minute hand come closer.

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
