

IDENTIFYING FEATURES OF HEMORRHOIDS — IN BABIES —

Signs and symptoms



Blood stains on the diaper and blood in stools, especially if your baby has constipation.

Inflammation and bleeding around the anal area.



Conditions that may be mistaken for hemorrhoids



Anal fissures are cracks in the anal skin that may cause bleeding while passing hard stools.

Rectal polyps may appear as raised bumps. They are usually harmless.

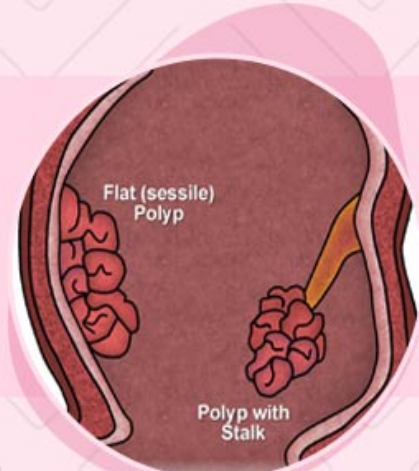
