



Tips To Follow When Using An Indoor/Outdoor Thermometer



Install the thermometer in an area with shade, away from direct sunlight.

Keep the thermometer covered to protect it from dirt, rain, and moisture.



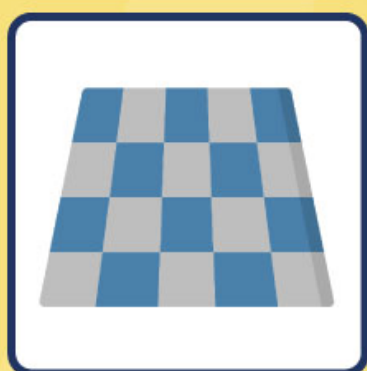
Install the thermometer at least five feet above the ground to avoid the heat from the ground interfering with the readings.

Ensure there's good airflow around the thermometer.



The northern side of the house could be the best location for the thermometer.

Ensure to place the instrument away from the fireplaces, dry vents, and air conditioners.



When used outside, ensure to situate the instrument above a grass or dirt terrain. Placing it over a pavement can lead to interference from heat.

Place the sensors within the operating range of the base station.
