



Dos And Don'ts Of Using An Infant Car Seat

Dos

Place the infant car seat in the rear seat only.



The harness should have a snug fit.

Ensure the chest clip is at the armpit level.



Ensure the straps stay flat without sagging.

Install the car seat at the right angle for maximum comfort.



Don'ts

Never use a car seat as a substitute for a crib.



Never use a forward-facing car seat for infants.

Never put the car seat on a kitchen countertop or an elevated surface.



Do not use the infant car seat when your baby outgrows the limits.

Avoid using the car seat if it is incompatible with your vehicle.
