



Safety Tips For Using An Electronic Toy



Read and understand the usage instructions before letting the child play with it.



Verify if the toy meets all CPSC's design and safety standards upon arrival.



Adhere to the battery-related instructions to prevent short-circuiting.



Check if the battery and electric enclosures of the toy are sturdy for rough play.



Ensure the power plugs fit snugly into the power outlets to prevent electrical shocks.



Ensure the child wears eye protection while playing with circuit-building sets.



Teach your child the proper usage of these toys and the dangers of electrical hazards.



Constantly supervise the child when playing with science-based electronic toys.



Ensure only an adult replaces the lights and batteries, not the child.



Discard the electric toy promptly if it is damaged beyond repair.
