



Line the chest with shelf liners to prevent wear and tear caused by toy friction.





Clean and dry dirty toys before storing them in the chest to prevent mildew.

Sort the toys based on their type — soft toys, board games, and blocks.





Store small building blocks in a plastic box before placing them in the chest.

Label the boxes or storage bins for easy identification and retrieval.





Seal less frequently used soft toys in zip-lock bags to protect them from moisture.

Place boxed toys at the bottom of the chest to ensure even and leveled storage.





Periodically clean the toy chest with an all-surface cleaner and cloth.
