

Vaccinations

For A Four-Month-Old

DTaP vaccine

Prevents diphtheria, tetanus, and pertussis (whooping cough)

Hib vaccine

Protects against Haemophilus influenzae type b disease in infants



IPV (inactivated polio vaccine) vaccine

Prevents poliomyelitis

RV (Rotavirus) vaccine

Provides protection against rotavirus infection. The 2nd dose of this vaccine is usually scheduled in the 4th month. The first and the third are given at two and six months, respectively.



PCV13 (pneumococcal conjugate) vaccine

Prevents pneumococcal disease caused by 13 types of pneumococcal bacteria

Meningococcal vaccine

Four months old babies with asplenia, complement inhibitor medication requirement, or persistent complement component deficiency receive the second dose of the meningococcal vaccine.
